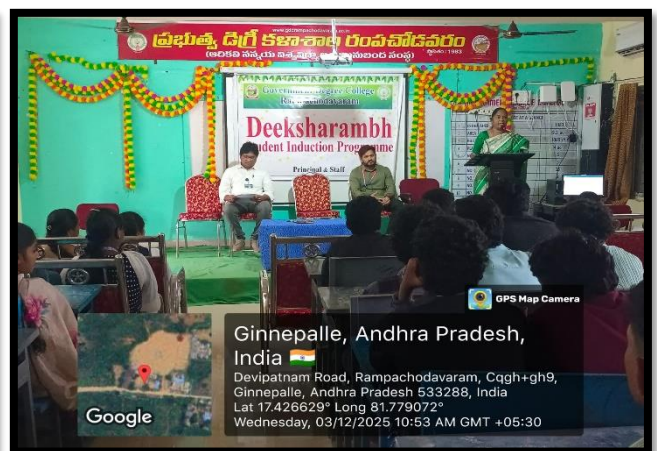
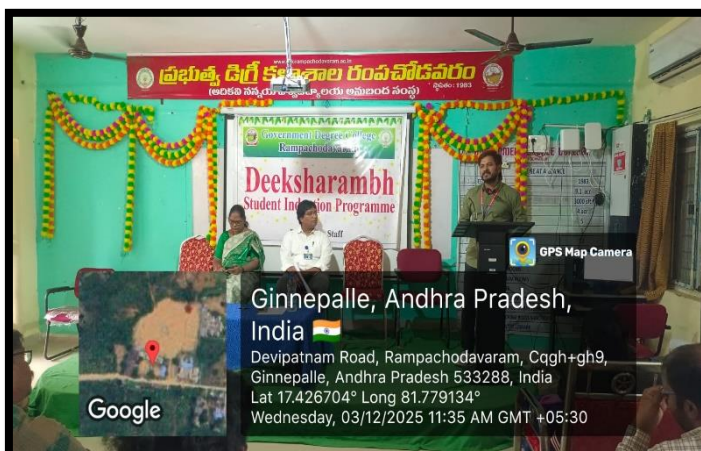
WORLD AIDS DAY 01-12-2025
